Public Feedback:

Dave Schofield was at the meeting to let the Selectmen know about malfunctioning septic systems on the Town Farm Road. There is an open cesspool which is a health issue and a danger to animals and children. Selectmen gave Dave Schofield, LPI and Charlie Porter CEO authority to address the issue. They will act as the Selectmen's "agents". Legal notice will be served on the property owners soon. The malfunctioning system will need to be replaced or the properties will be condemned after proper notification.

Treasurer's Warrant #10 for \$36,963.80 was reviewed and accepted. Account balances are ok.

Old Business:

Construction has begun on the new town office. Excavation is completed with foundation work being undertaken now.

TIF/UTAC update: Some possible uses for TIF funds are being discussed at the meetings. A Special Town Meeting will need to be called to authorize issuance of the funds.

Summer Road Work:

The first grading & compacting on gravel roads has been completed. Calcium still needs to be applied on certain roads.

Town Farm Road specs were discussed. They will be sent to Phil Curtis at Maine Local Roads Center before being advertised. The project needs to be put out for bid soon.
