## Minutes July 15, 2014

## Public Feedback:

Lynn Warman was at the meeting with some concerns about the cemeteries. The dust has been bad on Kanokolus Road (calcium will be spread soon) and the rocks that were moved by the grader prevent mowing to the edge of the road. Selectmen will check into having the area next to the road raked so that the contractor can mow without damaging his equipment.

Brian Jones, our representative to the Legislature was at the meeting to see if Unity residents have any concerns that he should be aware of.

Selectmen reviewed and approved minutes from the previous meeting.

Selectmen reviewed and signed Treasurer's Warrant #12 for \$65,035.83.

Old Business: Construction is underway on the new town office.

Selectmen signed the Special Catering Permit for UHOP for a wedding reception to be held at the Unity Centre for Performing Arts.

Selectmen reviewed the quote from Pike for paving on Town Farm Road. It was voted to do the following work in 2014.

- Reclaim the entire length of 1.6 miles to the Thorndike town line
- Pave (base coat) as far as \$200,000 will allow after reclaiming.

Selectmen have not appointed anyone to fill the Emergency Management Director position. They will mention it at the Special Town Meeting.
