Minutes April 21, 2015

Meeting opened at 6:30 p.m. Chris, Penny and Emily were present.

Minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed.

Selectmen signed Warrant #6 for \$21,693.29.

Selectmen reviewed account balances.

Selectmen reviewed the bids for a TAN. Camden National Bank offered the lowest interest rate of 0.76% for an amount not to exceed \$350,000. Selectmen voted to accept the proposal from Camden National Bank. Sue will notify the bond counsel to begin the paperwork for a 2015 TAN.

New Business:

New hire discussion – none at this meeting.

Road issues: Selectmen will explore the possibility of borrowing to pave the worst roads in town this summer. A Special Town Meeting will need to be held to ok borrowing. Penny would like to see a 5 year loan. Emily is also ok with borrowing, and ok with turning some of the worst roads back to gravel until they can be paved in the future. Selectmen will discuss road issues at their regular worksession on Thursday morning.

Chris will work with Dennis Jones to begin road clean up soon.

Selectmen discussed renting a power sweeper(s) to have volunteers clean along Pond Cemetery.

Selectmen signed the Waldo County Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Selectmen discussed the Transfer Station. It isn't open any longer on Crosby Brook Road. Tony Avila will accept metal at his business from 8-6 Monday – Thursday and Saturday by appointment.

Selectmen accepted Craig Lowe's proposal for a new sign for the Town Office. This will be paid for by a grant received from Jack Gibson. Donations of split perennials will be accepted for gardens around the sign and the town office.

Selectmen discussed the parking lot at the Firehouse and whether the funds would come from summer roads or the fire department budget. It was agreed that the parking lot needs to be fixed.
