Discussion regarding official definition of a working farm.

Discussion regarding problem of tractor trailers having to back in to the Family Dollar lot to unload, and the main road being blocked, seeming lack of adequate planning, etc.

Ken Murch discussed his progress in going door to door with Comprehensive Plan surveys and discussions with various townspeople. He has been encouraging people to attend meetings to stay informed.
